A meeting, having been duly posted, was held this date at the Dennis Water District, 80 Old Bass River Road, South Dennis and called to order by Paul F. Prue, Chairman at 10:00 AM. Water Commissioners Peter L. McDowell and Alan Tuttle was present. Also in attendance were David Larkowski, Superintendent and Sheryl A McMahon, Treasurer.

Call to Order

Discuss and Consider Signing Mutual Aid Agreement

Mr. Larkowski advised the Board that, given the recent State of Emergency declared by the Governor on March 10 concerning the Coronavirus outbreak, he shared with the Board the Massachusetts Water/Wastewater Agency Response Network (MA WARN) that would enable the Dennis Water District to seek and receive assistance with personnel, equipment and supplies during emergencies. The MA WARN provides a standard operating procedures document which outlines how things are managed during an emergency. Participating in a mutual aid agreement is something that Mr. Larkowski says he has been considering this for a while. The impending impacts of the spread of the coronavirus has brought this to the forefront for consideration. On a motion made by Peter L. McDowell, and duly seconded, the Board UNANIMOUSLY VOTED: to enter into the Massachusetts Water/Wastewater Agency Response Network (MA WARN) agreement.
